

Israel Palestine conflict resolution simulation

The Israel Palestine conflict resolution simulation is a program intended to educate participants about the Middle East conflict from an unbiased point of view. Materials are provided from different sources allowing participants to develop their own perspectives and opinions on the conflict. A model United Nations also allows participation from multiple aspects such as exploration of resources, collaboration with others, and development of new ideas.

The program will begin with the division of participants into multiple groups representing countries that have a part in the conflict. Group leaders will provide groups with necessary educational materials about their assigned country such as a summary of their role in the conflict and biased as well as unbiased media about the conflict regarding their country. Groups will discuss and come up with a resolution to the conflict that they feel is fair for all parties. New groups will then be formed with a representative from each country introducing their resolution to the new group. New groups will argue for the best resolution and then share their conclusion with the region.
